



Community Impact Project Examples

Below are examples of impactful projects that enhance community facilities and support critical services through meaningful improvements. **The examples are intended to support ideation and do not represent the full range of eligible projects; Lowe's will consider any project that improves a facility and delivers value to the broader community.**

- ✓ Supporting veterans by renovating nonprofit facilities that provide housing assistance, job training, or create places to gather for those who have served
- ✓ Revitalizing a community center to create safer, more welcoming spaces for after-school programs, job training, or senior activities
- ✓ Upgrading a food pantry with improved storage, refrigeration, or client-friendly spaces to better serve families in need
- ✓ Renovating classrooms or learning spaces at schools or education centers to support hands-on learning
- ✓ Improving a neighborhood park or playground to make it more accessible, inclusive, and safe for all ages
- ✓ Updating shelters or transitional housing facilities to create more dignified, functional spaces for people in transition
- ✓ Modernizing a nonprofit facility so staff and volunteers can serve more people efficiently
- ✓ Helping first responders better serve their community by building restorative and restful spaces to recharge between calls.
